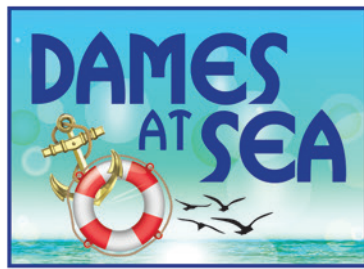
**FEB 14 - MARCH 24, 2019**
