The facility is also home to the renowned Northwest Indiana Symphony, The William J. Bachman Gallery, South Shore Arts, The South Shore Arts Gift Shop and our various Dining Venues. The William J. Bachman Gallery hosts a variety of art exhibits and is also available for your group to visit.
